

**ANTI-RAGGING MEASURES : SUBMISSION OF AFFIDAVIT BY THE
STUDENTS / PARENT / GUARDIAN**

Dear Parents/Guardian/Student,

You are fully aware of the orders of the Government and of Hon'ble Supreme Court on the Anti-Ragging measures. As per the latest policy all students and parent/guardians are required to submit an affidavit before a student is allowed for admission in the College. The format of Affidavits can be obtained from College office on a Non-Judicial paper of Rs.20/- duly attested by the oath commissioner/notary.

All parents/guardian/students may submit the same and get them duly attested by the Oath commissioner and bring it on the day of student's admission. Kindly note that there are two Affidavits as Annexure-I & II. The Annexure-I is to be signed by the student and Annexure-II shall be signed by the parent / guardian.

In case a student does not submit the same he/she shall not be allowed to the classes.

It is further, requested that this information be passed amongst friends.

6) I hereby declare that I have not been expelled or debarred from admission in any institution in the country on account of being found guilty of, abetting or being part of a conspiracy to promote, ragging; and further affirm that, in case the declaration is found to be untrue, I am aware that my admission is liable to be cancelled.

11. Collective punishment:- When the persons committing or abetting the crime or ragging are not identified, the college shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

Notification regarding Prevention of Ragging

An affidavit by the student and also by the Parent / Guardian is mandatory to be submitted at the time of registration to the forthcoming year in connection with Anti Ragging Drive. This is the text of the affidavits to be submitted by every student and also separately by the Parent / Guardian available in college office. All students of VIPS, are required to submit the above affidavits at the time of admission. The affidavits need to be on the stamp paper of Rs 20=00 duly attested by the Oath Commissioner / Notary. The above submission is compulsory as per the guidelines of the MCI & RGUHS and the Hon'ble Supreme Court in respect of the Anti-Ragging Drive. It is mandatory to submit the above affidavits failing which their admission shall not be treated as valid.

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
