Instructions for the students and parents

Fee and Deposits:

Fee for Government quota student is Rs. 3,75,000/- for academic year and for NRI category students a total \$ 25000/- or equivalent foreign currency for academic year. Fee is to be deposited in stipulated time (within six months of each term), failing to do so 10% late fee will be levied. Students not paying fees in the stipulated time frame will not be allowed to appear for the university examination.

Fee is to be paid by demand draft / online transfer on the name of “Gujarat Medical Education & Research Society Gandhinagar” payable at Gandhinagar. Pay-in-slip given by the Axis Bank should be used to pay the fees and it is mandatory to submit counterfoil at Student section, GMERS Medical College, Gotri, Vadodara.

College caution money, Library fee per term, Hostel - Fee and deposit for one term and student’ association fee per term will be collected at the time of reporting. Monthly Mess charges should be submitted to mess contractor directly.

Enrolment/Eligibility fee is to be paid to M.S. University of Baroda along with the enrolment/eligibility form. Examination fees, admission fees and other fees will be charged separately by The M.S. University of Baroda as per rules from time to time. You have to pay for Practical Journals. Please fill all the forms given with the information booklet. It is also available from college website and submit it with prescribed fees. Please fill it in capital letters and give correct information and at least two mobile numbers.

Students who are admitted under Government Quota will have to serve the Government of Gujarat for a period of one year after finishing their MBBS Course. Those who do not serve will have to pay rupees two lakhs if they have not availed any government scholarship benefits as the Bond fee.

All students will have to submit the **bond undertaking, anti-ragging undertaking in form of Annexure 1 and 2 online and hard copy and checklist with required documents** within 15 days of admission at student section.

Photographs: Please bring 20 coloured passport size photographs at the time of reporting; 1 for library membership, 3 for hostel forms, 1 for bank account, 1 for student association, 1 for student record section, 1 for identity card and rest will be extra photographs for other formalities.

Hostel:

There are separate hostels for boys and girls. Outstation students admitted to GMERS Medical College Gotri, who requires hostel accommodation shall fill in the necessary forms for hostel admission. Mess facility is compulsory for all students staying in Hostel. Any personal electronic or electric equipment or furniture or internet connection will not be allowed in the hostel at any cost. All hostels are well equipped with R.O. System, Water Cooler, Gym for Boys and Girls, TV, library. Facilities for Indoor Games like Table tennis, Carom board etc. and outdoor games as cricket, volleyball etc. are available. We have 24 hour security at the hostels. **Ragging is strictly prohibited in the campus and zero tolerance would be shown towards any such case.** Refer the Hostel Rules for further information.

3. The allotment of the room in the hostel will be done by Warden, who may change the room at any time he/she might think fit. No students shall change his/her room without prior permission of Warden
4. Application forms can be obtained from hostel office. Duly completed and signed form along with necessary document shall be submitted at hostel office.
5. Hostel fees will be Rs. 12000/- per year. The same fees will be applicable for internee hostel also. On admission student shall pay term fees in August and February in account section. Late fees of 10% will be levied up to ten days. Failing to do so the hostel admission will be cancelled.
6. Fees for Air condition in hostel room is Rs. 3000/- per month and fees for keeping refrigerator in room is Rs. 500/- per month.

7. Hostel deposit of Rs. 6000/- will be refunded on leaving the hostel. After submitting NOC from Warden. If the resident student fails to collect the same within one month the deposit will be forfeited.
8. Readmission to hostel and re-allotment of room will be done every academic year.

General Rules:

1. The students will have to stay in the room allotted by the Warden and cannot change without prior permission by the Warden.
2. In case unauthorized person is found to occupy any room of the hostel, the concerned student will be held responsible and have to face the disciplinary action.
3. If student(s) is found to have temporary accommodation outside or continuous absence for long time or does not stay in the allotted room then hostel admission will be cancelled. The fees & deposit in that case shall be forfeited and the student will not be given hostel admission in future.
4. No female student(s) or other female shall be allowed to enter the room of student in boys' hostel except in visitor's room and vice versa
5. Guests shall not be allowed to stay overnight without prior permission by the Warden / Chief Warden which shall be given under very special circumstances. The unauthorized stay is an offense and will call for punitive action.
6. Student will not be allowed to stay during vacation and should vacate rooms after annual examination. If student under certain circumstances have to stay during vacation shall have to take prior permission from the concerned authority.
7. In case students have to go outstation, prior permission is needed. Any student found absent for more than 2 days during week days without reason will have to face disciplinary action.
8. Student on leaving the premises or going outstation during public holidays, weekends and vacation shall lock the room & put off lights & fans. Student(s) have to see that all electrical fixtures are switched off for safety purposes when not in use & save energy. Tampering with electric fitting is strictly prohibited. Loud music is not allowed.
9. Students must maintain cleanliness in and around the hostel premises. Trash (waste, wrappers, leftover food etc.) if found outside the confined waste / dustbin area will be fined as decided by the Warden.
10. Lobbies, toilet & wash room sections should be kept clean .Taps found running in said areas will not be tolerated and punitive action will be taken lobby wise / floor wise.
11. Parking areas shall be kept clean and vehicles be parked in order
12. The student(s) of room is/ are required to sign receipt for furniture allotted and fittings to be used. The student(s) shall be held responsible for any damage done to doors, windows, furniture and any other fittings in their rooms. On leaving the hostel every student will have to hand over furniture items and fixtures in good condition. If not then student shall have to replace/repair/pay charges for its repair.
13. Any damage to common areas should be immediately reported to Warden /Chief Warden/Caretaker.

14. No student and hostel employee shall be allowed to consume/keep liquor of any kind or opium, charas, ganja, bhang, gutka, tobacco, cigarette or any addictive and prohibited substance in the hostel. Anyone found possessing or taking any of the above said substances shall be expelled from the hostel.
15. Student(s) should not keep any implement (fire arms, lethal weapons, poisons or intoxicants of any kind) in the hostel. If found possessing implement(s) will be expelled from hostel and will have to face police action.
16. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against student(s) found bullying, maltreating, teasing or indulging in any act of ragging is strictly prohibited. RAGGING IN ANY FORM IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
17. Student(s) is responsible for their own valuables. They should avoid keeping lot of cash and valuables. In case of theft it should be reported to Warden. Disputes and fights should be avoided.
18. Meetings & functions shall not be allowed without prior permission. Outsiders will not be invited/ allowed in said gatherings without prior permission.
19. The hostel employees shall not be abused or assaulted. Written complain should be given to the Warden//Hostel Superintendent about attendants and sweepers.
20. Change of Address shall be intimated immediately to the Warden/Chief Warden.

Mess Rules:

1. Local students may be allowed to have meals on payment fixed by mess committee.
2. Outsiders are not permitted in the mess except the relative/guest of the hostelite student.
3. Food from the mess will not be allowed to be carried to the rooms. Students will have to eat in the mess only.
4. No Tiffin service from any private owners shall be allowed in hostel premises.

Special Rules:

1. Visiting hours will be from 5-7 p.m. on all days.
2. The student(s) shall be in hostel by 9.00 pm. No student will be allowed after 9:00 pm without Warden's permission. The student will not be allowed to leave hostel before 6:00 am without a valid reason.
3. Roll call will be at 9:30 pm every day. No student will be allowed after roll call without permission.
4. Late night permission will be given only up to 11:00 pm by prior intimation in written to the Hostel Superintendent/ Warden. In case a student desires to be later than 11:00 pm he/she needs to get recommendation from local guardian also. Any student staying out beyond the stipulated time will have to face disciplinary action. Late pass will have to be taken in advance.
5. Frequent outstation will not be permitted.
6. Local guardian has to be approved by student's parents. Address proof and phone number of local guardian and parents should be attached with hostel admission form.
7. Incomplete application forms for hostel admission will not be accepted.

Disciplinary Rules:

Any excuse(s) for Ignorance of rules will be not be accepted. Every hostel resident shall have read the hostel rules as a copy of the same is provided to them.

1. Resident who violates the rules will have to face disciplinary/punitive action like leaving the hostel as decided by the appointed committee.
2. Penalties imposed will be solely by the Warden/Hostel Superintendent.
3. If student(s) fail to vacate the room on completion of course / leaves hostel locking the room without informing, then belongings will be noted and confiscated by the authorities.
4. If any student is found to possess any illegal items like drug, alcohol or any other illegal activities, he/she will have to face disciplinary/punitive action like leaving the hostel as decided by the appointed committee.

Mentorship Program

Structure of the Mentorship Program:

Mentorship program is designed to facilitate academic performance of undergraduate students.

Scope of the Mentorship Program:

- The Mentor team will provide guidance to the Mentees, to improve academic performance and to prepare them for their career goals.
- Mentors will review and follow the Mentee's attendance and academic performance, as these are the main criteria for eligibility of students to appear in the University examination.
- Each Mentoring group consists of 4 to 8 faculties, one each from Phase 1 & Phase 2 of MBBS and 2 or more, from Phase 3 MBBS.
- Twelve students from each phase of MBBS (Batch 2024-25 onwards), are assigned to each mentoring group. The students are first assigned when they begin their First year of MBBS course.
- The Mentoring group remains fixed for the duration of 5.5 years, the duration of the MBBS course.

Responsibilities of the Mentee

The mentee should take charge and initiate communications. He or she should attend the mentorship meeting and be on time for mentorship meetings. Personal issues and problems may be discussed by a mentee. But excess dependency on the mentor for personal and professional support may become a drain on the mentor's energy. Problems related to food, hostel facilities etc should be handled by the designated administrative staff.
